February – the month of sharing Valentine cards and candy! Here are some fun ideas to try with your family. These are special ways to build your bond with your children and encourage their self-esteem. You can also encourage your child to do some of these ideas for those they love! Enjoy the process. Send “fan mail.” Praise your child’s qualities and efforts in a note, poem or silly riddle. Send it through the post office. Or leave it under their pillow or anywhere else she will find it. Sign it, “From your biggest fan.”

Make a date. Each month, devote one day to your child. Write it on the calendar. Let them choose what to do and eat.

Give your child a place of honor. At dinner, put your child at the head of the table. Serve them first and make a water or milk toast to them. As at testimonial dinners, have each person say only nice things about the honored guest. (Siblings will try hard to do this, as they know their turn will be coming.)

Create a mini-museum. In addition to the refrigerator, dedicate a wall in the house as a place to hang your child’s art, writing, test papers and certificates. Change the “exhibits” often.

Provide “room service.” Surprise your child when they’re getting ready for bed. Bring a healthy snack to their room. Take time to chat about their day.
