Greetings! Isn't it fun to see the sunshine and the signs of Spring? I've heard the happy chatter this week as students were able to go outside for recess! This month I'd like to highlight screen time. Did you know that **establishing non-screen time** is important for overall student and family health? Excessive screen time is linked to obesity, aggression, and behavior issues. Setting limits on screen time will encourage physical and creative activities. Here are some steps to reducing screen time: 1. Make a Family Media Plan. Talk with your children and let them help set the times the devices will be off (parents, too!) 2. Agree to **daily** "tech-free time", including all devices and the TV! 3) Stop using all digital devices at least one hour before bed. Remove the devices from your child's room overnight. 4) Model for your child! Leave your phone in your pocket when you have an opportunity to talk, play, read, or create. Keep a book, crayons, or board games close by for playing together. 5) Get outside and play, take a walk, or enjoy a healthy snack on the porch. Here is a link with excellent ideas and resources.
