Four Key Elements of the Instructional Post-Conference

Conducting the Post-Conference: To be discussed at Day 3 Training prior to conducting the post-conference

- 1. Introduction/Greeting/Establish Length
 - Review Conference Process
 - General Impression Question
 - "How do you think the lesson went?"
- 2. Reinforcing the Teacher
 - Identify an area of Reinforcement (ONLY one area)
 - Ask Self-Analysis Question
 - Provide evidence from notes
- 3. Refining the Teacher's Skill:
 - Identify an area of Refinement (ONLY one area)
 - Ask Self-Analysis Question
 - Provide evidence from notes
 - Give a recommendation for future practice
- 4. Present evidence and rating connected to the rubric
