Free Meals For Students:

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) has extended the free meal program until June of 2022. This extension will allow schools to continue to serve free meals, both breakfast and lunch, to all students in the school district.

Although we are currently able to offer free meals to all students, we encourage parents who feel they may qualify for free/reduced meals to turn in an application to be processed. We cannot waive school fees without a completed and qualified meal application. In addition school districts are eligible to receive certain federal and state funding (grants) based on the number of qualified free/reduced meal applications that they have processed. Completing the free/reduced lunch forms is important to our school even though the meals are free!
