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Classroom News

- Just like in the regular classroom, I set goals for the students that I work with. Here are the goals we are working on this month:
 - **3rd/4th grade reading:** Students will read multi-syllable words with 95% accuracy.
 - **5th grade reading:** Students will meet their individual fluency goals.
 - **6th grade reading:** Students will score a 90% or higher on a vocabulary test.
 - **5th/6th grade math:** Students will multiply and divide multi-digit numbers with 90% accuracy

What is Title I?

Title I is a government funded program that allows schools to hire tutors and purchase supplies to help students be successful academically. My day is spent supporting students and teachers in and out of the classroom.
